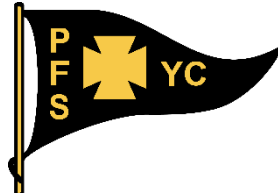

Notice of Race – Sunday 29 March 2026

1 Rules

Races will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing (2025-2028)* (RRS); the prescriptions of Australian Sailing, the Class Rules, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

2 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be sent by email to registered competitors on or before 27 March 2026.

Sailing instructions will be available in the PFSYC office from mid-March 2026.

3 Communication

Radio communication during the race shall be available on Club Channel 68

4 Eligibility & Entry

The event is open to all keelboats in Division I & II, III & IV.

Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form to members@pfsyc.com.au by 5pm on Wednesday 25 March 2026.

6 Venue

The race will start and finish at the Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club and the course will cover west of Blackwall Reach, through Mosman Bay, Freshwater Bay around Karrakatta bank, and Melville Water East and West.

7 Scoring & Handicaps

Handicaps as declared by PFSYC Handicapper will apply.

Handicaps and Divisions will be posted on the notice board downstairs on the river side of the PFSYC building next to the Hew Jarman Centreboard room on Saturday 28 March 2026 prior to the race. They will also be available at the PFSYC Members Bar or from the office. Boats must sail in the Division to which they are allocated.

8 Risk Statement

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club (Inc) and/or its officials or assistants are not responsible for the seaworthiness of any competing boats, or the competence of any competing crew. On making entry, the entrant agrees that the Club or its officials are not liable for any damage, loss or injury to any person or property incurred in or before or after any Club event.

9 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

10 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Fastest Time in each division on each handicap. Presentation of prizes will be held in the Mele Bilo Room of the Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club on **Friday 10 April 2026 at 6:30pm**. All crews and their guests are invited to attend.
